BIOGRAPHY

Kerry, who holds a diploma in music theatre performance and a background in musical theatre, has graced stages across England and internationally for the past 20 years. Her performances span a variety of venues, from the Tivoli Theatre in Wimborne, to outdoor festivals like the widely celebrated Floral Fringe Fair, where she's been a favourite for the past eight years.

Kerry has also been honoured to perform at special events, including the 'Survivor's Dinner' for the Sagratino Cup in Umbria, Italy, and even as far afield as Myanmar.

Other highlights include a multi-venue, multi-year 'residency' for the Rural Crafts Association of Great Britain which involved performances at the prestigious Burghley Horse Trials.

In 2022, Kerry decided to go back to her musical theatre roots and set herself the challenge of creating, producing, directing and starring in her own one-woman musical theatre show, *Femmes Fatales*, which explored and celebrated the diversity of leading ladies in musical theatre.

Revelling in being back on the stage again, two years later, Kerry created a new offering *Rainy Days, Mondays & Good Old Dreams*, a show which sensitively explores the music and lives of the Carpenters. Now in its third year, this show is touring successfully across the UK.
